1 House White Selection 2015

Chenin Blanc, The Reserve Bank, Swaartland, South Africa

Made by the brilliant Marinda Kruger-van Eck. Wonderfully crisp, fruity dry wine, notes of apple, citrus and blossom "Ridiculously easy to drink, give it a go"

2 Pinot Grigio 2015

Vinazza, Venetie, Italy

A vibrant Pinot Grigio with floral notes and hints of almond and pear, complimented by the addition of Venetie's best white grape Garganega, which is also used in Soave.

3 Riesling 2013

Emiliana, Bio Bio Valley, Chile

The Reserve Bank, South Africa

A bright juicy wine from a blend of grapes such as Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon & Shiraz. It makes a wine that is incredibly expressive and with plenty of ripe fruit.

10 Merlot 2015

Tierra Alta, Central Valley, Chile

Old vine cool-climate-, mountain Merlot from the Martin family. Fresh bramble fruits & stewed black fruit flavours with hints of dark chocolate & spice. "A real Merlot mouthful, drink with abandon!"

11 Malbec 2015

The Listening Station, Geographe, Australia

Intense ripe blackcurrant aromas with aromatic spices of clove and vanilla. The sumptuous ripe fruit lingers on the palate.

12 Cabernet Sauvignon 2014

Western Cape, South Africa

Sourced from vineyards that border the warm Wellington and Swartland regions, from vines over 25 years old. This has lovely varietal expression - taut and leafy but also brambly, bright and succulent.

13 Shiraz 2012

Craigmoor Estate, Mudgee, Australia

A beautiful mid-garnet colour with classic red berry fruit aromas and a hint of oak. The palate continues these flavours - redcurrant, raspberry and blackberry with spice and white pepper notes.
